Erasmus+ Project “Young Voices, Big Changes” Approved

We are proud to announce that the Erasmus+ Youth Exchange project “**Young Voices, Big Changes**” has been officially approved under the Erasmus+ Programme (KA152 - Mobility of Young People).

The project will be implemented between **January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026**, coordinated by **Asociația Justiție și Tineret JUST (Romania)**, in partnership with organizations from **Poland, Hungary, Bulgaria and the Czech Republic**.

About the Project

“Young Voices, Big Changes” aims to **empower young people to actively participate in democratic life**, strengthening their understanding of democracy, civic engagement and decision-making processes.

Through this project, **40 young people and youth leaders** aged 18–30 will take part in an international youth exchange, where they will develop key competences in:

- active citizenship
- democratic participation
- critical thinking and advocacy
- intercultural dialogue

Planned Activities

The project will include a diverse range of non-formal education activities such as:

- interactive workshops on democracy and civic engagement
- role-playing simulations (e.g. mock elections, debates)
- group discussions on social issues
- study visits to local institutions
- creation of educational materials (videos, campaigns, etc.)

Expected Impact

The project will contribute to:

- increasing youth participation in democratic processes
- empowering young people to advocate for their rights
- strengthening intercultural understanding and cooperation
- promoting European values such as inclusion, tolerance and active citizenship

In addition, the results will be shared through workshops, local events and online campaigns, reaching **hundreds of young people across partner countries**.
